- 1 month of flea prevention
- Toys/bedding if viable

Dog Anxiety Awareness Week 2025: May 5th-May 11th

Anxiety is "ruff" enough when you're a human: Census data tells us that approximately 31% of the US population deals with some form of anxiety disorder, and much like we share our couches (and sometimes our snacks \odot) with our dogs, we also share our problems: a Finnish study revealed that 15–20% of dogs on average experience some form of separation anxiety, and noise sensitivity is the most common source of anxiety, with 32% of dogs showing some form of sensitivity to loud or prolonged noises.

How can we help/support our furry friends? Let's look at the "paws" abilities!

Form Routines: Many anxious dogs feel relief when they know what to expect: daily walks, feedings, playtime, and sleep schedules are all excellent ways to create ritual and routine!

Play Detective: Take inventory of your dog's day-to-day: is he eating or drinking less? Has she been sleeping in a new location? There may be anxiety triggers in the home or environment that may need investigating!

Create a "Quiet Corner": Many dogs respond well to soothing pets or massage, calming music, or a familiar item of bedding or a toy that is always accessible.


Seek Veterinary Care: If your dog is experiencing intense anxiety, your veterinarian may be able to provide medication, or recommend other forms of therapy.
